

The Media Council of Bermuda is the eight-strong panel that hears complaints against the media. It has five lay members (including a chairman) with no current connection to the news media and three members nominated by the media, one each to represent print, broadcast and web. The council is scheduled to meet monthly but this could change subject to the volume of complaints.

Members will sit on the council for a minimum of one year; their tenure will be reviewed annually by the Appointments Committee.
